Conflict of Interest (Code po0144.3)

- Board members shall perform their official duties in an ethical manner and free from conflict of interest pursuant to 19.59, Wis. Stats.
 - Board President has a conflict of interest while being on the Board and being involved in a political group. She has used her position on the board when advertising for a speech. She has spoken on behalf of the Board and/or Wrightstown while at the Brown County Fair. Whether or not she is getting paid for this or other speeches, it still results in a conflict of interest. To allow for full transparency, a Board President would normally inform her fellow Board members of activities such as these. She is promoting her personal agenda instead of following what the school district and students need. The Board President position is not to be used for personal gain.
